



## **UPDATED COVID POLICY**

1. Parents will have the option to allow their child to unmask indoors and/or outdoors;
2. If there is 1 positive Covid case of an individual in a classroom, that individual will quarantine for 5 days from the date of positive result; individual who tested positive may return on Day 6 but **MUST WEAR A MASK** (regardless of unmasking option) from Day 6-Day 10 (this number will vary based on weekend days);
3. (Continued) When there has been 1 positive case of an individual in a class, those who were unmasked in that class, will have to isolate for 5 days and return on Day 6 (no testing required). In order to return on Day 4. (We will clarify the date in this case).
4. For those who decide to have their child return on Day 6, if these individuals who isolated for 5 days, return with any signs or symptoms such as a runny nose, cough, fever or congestion (breathing through their mouth) they will need to be picked up and they will be required to have a PCR test in order to return to school.
5. (Continued) 1 positive case: Classroom will not close; For the individuals who are already opt-IN for their child to wear a mask indoors, they will be able to return to school the next day, masked as usual. It will be the parent's choice whether to keep their child (who masks indoors) home to isolate or test as a result of the positive case.



6. If there are 2 or more ADDITIONAL positive Covid cases in the same classroom (=3 total) as a result of the initial positive result OR within 10 school days, the remaining exposed students will need to isolate and have a PCR test (or proctored home test-which we may be able to provide while our supplies last) completed no sooner than Day 4 from the last exposure date. Upon a negative PCR test result, students can return to school on Day 4, before 10:00 am (if the negative result is provided in that timeframe). Otherwise, the student with a negative PCR (or at-home proctored Covid test) can return to school on Day 5. Parents may opt not to do a Covid test and therefore, their child can return on Day 6 without a test.

**These scenarios remain constant:**

Any child who tests positive for Covid can return on Day 6 but must mask from Day 6-Day 10 regardless of the mask choice:

In the case of 1 positive Covid case, no classrooms will close:

3 or more positive Covid cases from one incident OR within 10 school days in the same classroom: See #6.

We are not requiring a PCR test upon return on Day 6, after 5-day isolation unless a child is showing any signs or symptoms.

In order to have your child return on Day 4 instead of Day 6, they will need a PCR test (or see #6) (date to be clarified with Kim Vargas or Aide Castro) before scheduling test in order for the Covid test result to be accepted.



We will report classroom cases to the classroom families and any others who would be considered close contacts.

For travel, there will be situations when you will be asked to provide a home Covid test or a PCR test (depending on the circumstances) before your child can return to TVP. The same rule about signs and symptoms will still apply if your child starts to display the above-described signs/symptoms within 1-5 days of returning from travel, even if they tested negative upon returning to school. In that situation, a PCR test will be required.
